Mayors Message

We are now through the first quarter and on into a beautiful Spring. March has been a busy month for Council and Staff. Our CAO has resigned and moved. We wish him well, and thank him for the years he spent in Port Edward. We have engaged a consulting firm to help us in finding a new CAO. Jason Giesbrecht has accepted the position of Fire Chief. Council and myself are confident that Jason will do very well as our New Volunteer Fire Chief. I would also like to thank Shawn Pettitt for his 31 years of service, 13 of which he was the Fire Chief.

It is with a great amount of regret that we still are subject to the CN whistling. We are trying to track down the reason that the cessation of whistling has not happened. Staff are working on it and we have arranged a meeting with CN in early May. CN is currently double tracking the railroad from near the boat launch to past North Pacific Cannery. They will be building a new boat launch road and there could be some disruptions. We will keep on top of the construction progress.

We received good news from the Provincial Government. Port Edward received \$2.1 million dollars, the funds will be used for infrastructure. This will help in rebuilding our roads and other services.

The first of the propane shipments to Ridley Island began arriving this week. We will soon begin the annual budget process and relevant information will be mailed out to all residents.

CN Message

This message is from the Manager of Public Affairs:

CN is investing in its network leading to the Port of Prince Rupert. The capital infrastructure investments are aimed at improving fluidity and reducing the potential for crossing blockages. This work will take place on CN right-of-way between the Cannery and Porpoise Drive and is scheduled throughout 2019 on the following (approximate) dates:

- Brush Clearing: February – March, 2019
- Grading Work: March – June 2019
- Estimated Track Construction start date: September 2019

Bear Aware



Spring is upon us and we would like to remind residents to properly secure your refuse.

Please **DO NOT** store your garbage outside, this is the leading cause for bears to wander into neighborhoods.

Pet food, bird seed, ripe fruit, smokers and barbeques as well as petroleum products, small live stock and composts will also attract bears.

Please manage these items properly by keeping them indoors or make sure they are clean from odors. Also, please do not feed other wildlife.

If you see a bear give it room, do not make eye contact, bare your teeth or run.

Make yourself big, create noise, back away and most importantly give it an exit route. A cornered bear is a dangerous bear. Please report your sightings to:
