Also, ensure your dog has a current dog license, see bylaw #519 for details on our website.



Port Edward Boat Launch Rules & Regulations

We want to ensure that all boat launch users have the ability to launch and load their boats with minimal wait times.

- Tying your boat to the dock is at a 15 minute maximum and we request that you tie to the end of the float to ensure that other users are not restricted from using it.
- Please drop off your fish for cleaning and pull your vehicle and trailer out of the area. Ensure the table is clean when you leave.
- Ensure fish remains are dumped in deep water, so that they are not exposed at low tide.
- Please obey the “No Parking” signs at all times.



Bear Aware

Summer is here and we would like to request that all Port Edward Residents help out when it comes to keeping bears out of the community. **Please ensure that all your refuse is placed in a garbage bag and inside a sealed, water tight container with a lid.**



Properly storing or securing residential garbage and other bear attractants is a proven method for discouraging bears and preventing nuisance problems around homes and neighborhoods.

Bears are attracted to: Garbage Cans, Bird Feeders, Pet Food, BBQ Grills, Smokers, Compost, Beehives, Fruit and Nut Trees, Petroleum Products, Rabbits, Chickens and Small Livestock. These items should be properly managed.

- If you see a bear; remain calm, don't panic. Often the bear is simply looking for food and will move on if it finds nothing to eat.
- Keep away from the bear and go inside with children and pets.
- Never approach the bear and don't run from the bear.
- Do not act submissively by crouching down or whispering.
- Warn others of the bears presence, but don't do it by yelling. If the bear climbs a tree, keep people and pets away. Eventually when things quiet down, the bear will come down and leave. This usually happens after dark when the bear feels safe.
- Once the bear is safely out of the area, check your yard to ensure there are no attractants available.
