

# District Update

## Clean, Neat and Green

### Mayors Message

Spring is here and we will be having a Spring clean up in May. We encourage residents to use this service to keep Port Edward "Clean, Neat and Green".

We are still dealing with the train whistling issue. We are attempting to set up a meeting in early May with the CN to understand what the delay is in having the whistling stopped. CN is constructing a new passing track from the boat launch to North Pacific Cannery, which is causing a lot of truck and vehicle traffic. This construction could go well into the fall.

We have been getting feedback from bus users on the new bus fares and schedule. We raised the bus fares to try to recover some of the costs to the District. The current bus schedule operating cost is \$342,000 per year. The total fares collected in 2018 was \$33,000 or less than 10% of the total costs. The District of Port Edward property tax payers contribute \$154,000 and the Province of BC contribute \$156,000, about 46%. Council will review the bus schedule and the costs in the fall and assess the financial and service impact to the community. We appreciate the feedback on the schedule and the fares. If you have any questions, concerns or feedback please call our office and we will use this information as part of the review this fall.

AltaGas and CN sponsored LPG Firefighting training for the firefighters in Prince Rupert and Port Edward. The training took place over a long weekend and consisted of a classroom session followed by a practical session with 3 different props to simulate flaming propane leaks. Firefighters from Port Edward attended the sessions and dealt with flaming LPG leaks head on. CN will be conducting more training for the firefighters later this year to help deal with potential rail car incidents.
