4. WORKSHOP ON ACCESSIBILITY PLAN

4.1. Workshop on Accessibility Plan

The Prince Rupert & Area Accessibility Committee reviewed existing actions and additions relating to Outdoor Recreation, including parks, fields, and recreational spaces as follows:

- V. Stewart reviewed priorities relating to "Outdoor Recreation." The Committee discussed:
 - Considering new accessible washrooms for outdoor recreational areas;
 - Promoting Seal Cove Salt Marsh as an accessible trail;
 - Exploring Christmas trolley bus tours for residents of Acropolis Manor;
 - Promoting Bocce as an accessible sport;
 - Examining accessibility of Victoria Field and George Casey Park;

- Highlighting that the swinging gate at Charles Hays Secondary School is locked and prevents access for wheelchairs;
- Considering the spread of accessible spaces across the City; and
- Exploring accessible picnic tables at parks; and
- Supporting the development of Cloud Berry Trail.

The following items were also discussed and will be included under the Transportation topic:

- Exploring HandyDart operating hours and whether it can be used to bring people to visit recreational areas; and
- Supporting the purchase of wider bus shelters.

The following items were also discussed and will be included under the Civic Facilities topic:

> o Installing handheld showers in the Earl Mah Aquatic Centre changing rooms as well as the shower beside the sauna.

5. DISCUSSION OF GRANT OPPORTUNITY

5.1 The Prince Rupert & Area Accessibility Committee discussed the \$25,000 grant offered through SPARC BC and V. Stewart asked the Committee to identify ideas to improve accessibility that may currently be cost-prohibitive.

The Committee also discussed looking into other grant opportunities at Elks of Canada, Rick Hansen Foundation, and the Lions Clubs International.

That the Prince Rupert & Area Accessibility Committee directed staff to investigate applications to the SPARC BC Local Community Accessibility Grant Program for the following items:

- An aluminum wheelchair ramp for the Lester Centre of the Arts;
- A stainless steel pool lift for The Earl Mah Aquatic Centre;
- An audio-visual system for hearing impaired for the Lester Centre of the Arts; and
- A video magnifier device and an assistive reading pen for the Prince Rupert Library;

And that staff report back to the Prince Rupert & Area Accessibility Committee at a future meeting.
