I hope this message finds you all well.

Road construction and utility repairs are just about finished. We have finished paving Sunset. It looks great. Sidewalks will be done weather permitting. Oceanview is awaiting the finishing of the curbs and paving. The contractor will be sculpting the driveways before finishing up this job. Oceanview has all new sewer, storm sewer and water mains where necessary.

Port Edward has attracted some new businesses this year. Ocean Trailers just opened a state-of-the-art trailer repair and leasing site. When fully operational they will have up to 10 employees. Two other businesses both linked to fishing. North Delta Seafoods have established a new offloading site at the Port Edward Harbour Authority. The facility is geared to working twelve months of the year and able to handle multiple species. Cold Fish has bought the old Grand Hale facility and will be custom processing various fish products. We wish them much success.

Council will meet in early November to start the budgeting process for 2024. This will allow us to get a head start on next years projects and prioritize the work to be done.

Highlights from October Council Meetings

- Council has agreed to partner with the City of Prince Rupert and the Regional District to host the 2025 NCLG Association conference to be held in Prince Rupert.
- Grant in Aid was provided to the following groups: Prince Rupert Special Events
- Society- Winterfest; Prince Rupert Rotary Club; Prince Rupert Halloween Fest and the Ts'msyen Prosperity Society.
- Elsie Lemke was appointed as the Interim CAO, as the recruitment of a permanent CAO gets underway.
- The Community Center rental policy and procedures were updated.
- The District of Port Edward now has a flag policy, that outlines how flags are to be flown, respecting jurisdictional order.
- A Development Variance was approved for the Cabins on Spruce Avenue.
- A Sewer Service Agreement with Prince Rupert Port Authority has been approved.
- New Water & Sewer Rates have been approved for 2024, with slight increases to both utilities.
- The Council Remuneration Bylaw has been updated, providing for an annual increase based on the Consumer Price Index.
