Interested persons can obtain information on the requirements and procedures for making nominations including nomination forms at the Port Edward District Office, 770 Pacific Avenue, Port Edward, BC during regular office hours (8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays or weekends) or on our website at portedward.ca beginning August 4, 2026.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet ALL the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (October 17, 2026);
- Resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- Not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an

election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Candidate Expense Limits Mayor: \$12,232.78

Candidate Expense Limits Councillor: 6,161.89

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local elections, the following third-party advertising limits apply (September 19, 2026 to October 17, 2026):
